Author agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless SPI, and its respective members, directors, officers, employees and agents from and against any claims, causes of action, losses and damages (including reasonable attorneys’ fees) or liabilities in connection with any breach or alleged breach or the foregoing warranties.
